

3. No slope shall be greater than 3:1 and shall be either sodded or seeded and mulched.

4. The grading and elevations shown on the grading plans are for construction purposes only. Finished grades and slopes will vary in elevations from those shown on the plans depending upon the location, size and type of house built on the lot. However, care should be taken to insure that finished grading conforms to drainage

5. As needed, siltation fence shall be installed as a protective barrier for trees to remain.

6. A Geotechnical Engineer shall be employed by the owner and be on site during grading operations. All Soils tests shall be verified by the Geotechnical Engineer concurrent -with the grading and backfilling operations-
