

#### LANDSCAPE NOTES


- SITE MULCH SHALL MATCH EXISTING SITE. CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL RIVER ROCK MULCH MULCH AT 3" THICKNESS OVER WEED BARRIER IN ALL PROPOSED AND DISTURBED LANDSCAPE AREAS.
- 2. LANDSCAPE PLANTINGS SHALL MATCH EXISTING SITE SPECIFICATIONS. NOTIFY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT IF SPECIES SPECIFIED VARY FROM EXISTING SITE.
- 3. WEED BARRIER POLYETHYLENE FILTER FABRIC DESIGNED TO PERMIT WATER INFILTRATION WHILE PREVENTING WEED GROWTH—TO BE INSTALLED IN ALL PLANTING BEDS.

#### IRRIGATION NOTE

1. CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY IF EXISTING IRRIGATION IS PRESENT. IF FOUND THE EXISTING IRRIGATION SYSTEM SHALL BE MODIFIED AND TIED INTO THE EXISTING TO PROVIDE 100% COVERAGE OF THE LANDSCAPE AREA SITE. AREAS WITHIN 5 FEET OF BUILDING WALLS SHALL BE IRRIGATED BY DRIP IRRIGATION OR SIMILAR. CONTRACTOR SHALL ENSURE BUILDING WALLS AND WINDOWS WILL NOT BE DAMAGED OR STAINED BY IMPROPER IRRIGATION INSTALLATION OR POOR SELECTION OF FIXTURES. SYSTEM SHALL INCLUDE ALL APPURTENANCES, COMPLY WITH CITY CODE & BE APPROVED BY OWNER.

#### <u>GUARANTEE</u>

1. CONTRACTOR SHALL GUARANTEE ALL PLANTS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FROM DATE OF PROJECT ACCEPTANCE BY THE OWNER.



GENERAL NOTES:

PRUNE ROOTS IF BALL IS ROOTBOUND. REMOVE ALL CONTAINERS AND NON—BIODEGRADABLE BURLAP. WHEN BACKFILLING PLANT PIT, PLACE PLANTING SOIL IN TWO LIFTS. AFTER FIRST LIFT, PUDDLE SOIL IN WITH WATER TO REMOVE ALL AIR POCKETS. PLACE SECOND LIFT AND REPEAT. CONTINUE TO PUDDLE AND FILL AS NECESSARY.

# PLANTING DETAIL: SHRUBS

PRUNE BRANCHES IF BROKEN OR DAMAGED—SEE DETAIL THIS SHEET.

GALVANIZED STEEL WIRE, SAFETY FLAGGING AND BLACK RUBBER HOSE AS SPECIFIED.

PLANT TREES AT SAME GROUND LEVEL THEY WERE GROWN IN THE NURSERY (GRAFT LOCATED HERE FOR ROOTSTOCK)

3" MULCH TO MATCH EXISTING SITE

REMOVE TOP \$ OF BURLAP, TWINE, ROPE AND BASKET FROM ROOTBALL

2" X 4" WOOD STAKE
FINISHED GRADE

BACKFILL WITH SOIL FROM PLANT PIT (REMOVE ALL DEBRIS, SEE NOTE)

SCARIFY SIDES OF PLANTING HOLE

BREAK 6" SUB—SOIL AS NECESSARY

3 X BALL DIAMETER

GENERAL NOTES:

IF ROOTBALL IS WRAPPED IN NON-BIODEGRADEABLE BURLAP, REMOVE ENTIRE WRAP AFTER PLACED IN PIT. WHEN BACKFILLING PLANT PIT, PLACE PLANTING SOIL IN TWO LIFTS. AFTER FIRST LIFT, PUDDLE SOIL IN WITH WATER TO REMOVE ALL AIR POCKETS. PLACE SECOND LIFT AND REPEAT. CONTINUE TO PUDDLE AND FILL AS NECESSARY.
