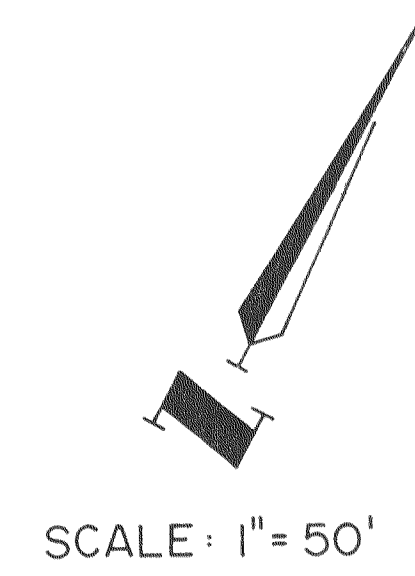


U.S. HIGHWAY NO. 79
