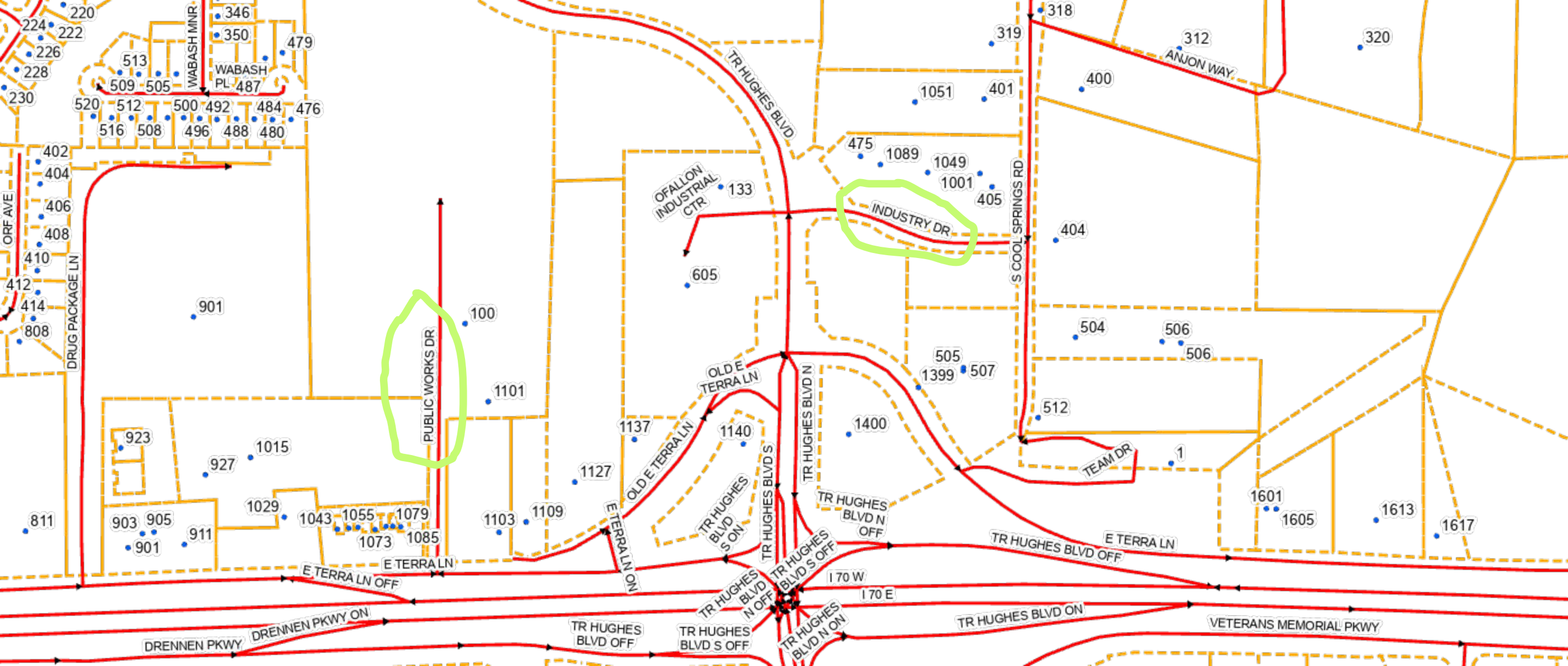

**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE EXISTING “PUBLIC WORKS DRIVE” TO
“INDUSTRY DRIVE” AND RE-ASSIGNING THE NAME “PUBLIC WORKS DRIVE”
TO A NEW ROADWAY IN THE CITY OF O’FALLON.**

WHEREAS, the existing Public Works facility is relocating away from Public Works Drive to a new location off Old East Terra Lane making the use of the name Public Works Drive at its current location illogical; and

WHEREAS, City staff has coordinated with the Economic Development Department and St. Charles County Emergency Management on renaming the former Public Works Drive as “Industry Drive”; and

WHEREAS, the new roadway leading into the new Public Works facility requires a name and can be named “Public Works Drive”; and

WHEREAS, the attached exhibits depict the roadways that will have new names assigned to them in accordance with this legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O’FALLON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The City of O’Fallon hereby renames the existing “Public Works Drive” to “Industry Drive” as shown on Exhibit A attached to this ordinance.

SECTION 2: The City of O’Fallon hereby assigns the name “Public Works Drive” to the new roadway off Old East Terra Lane as shown on Exhibit B attached to this ordinance.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.

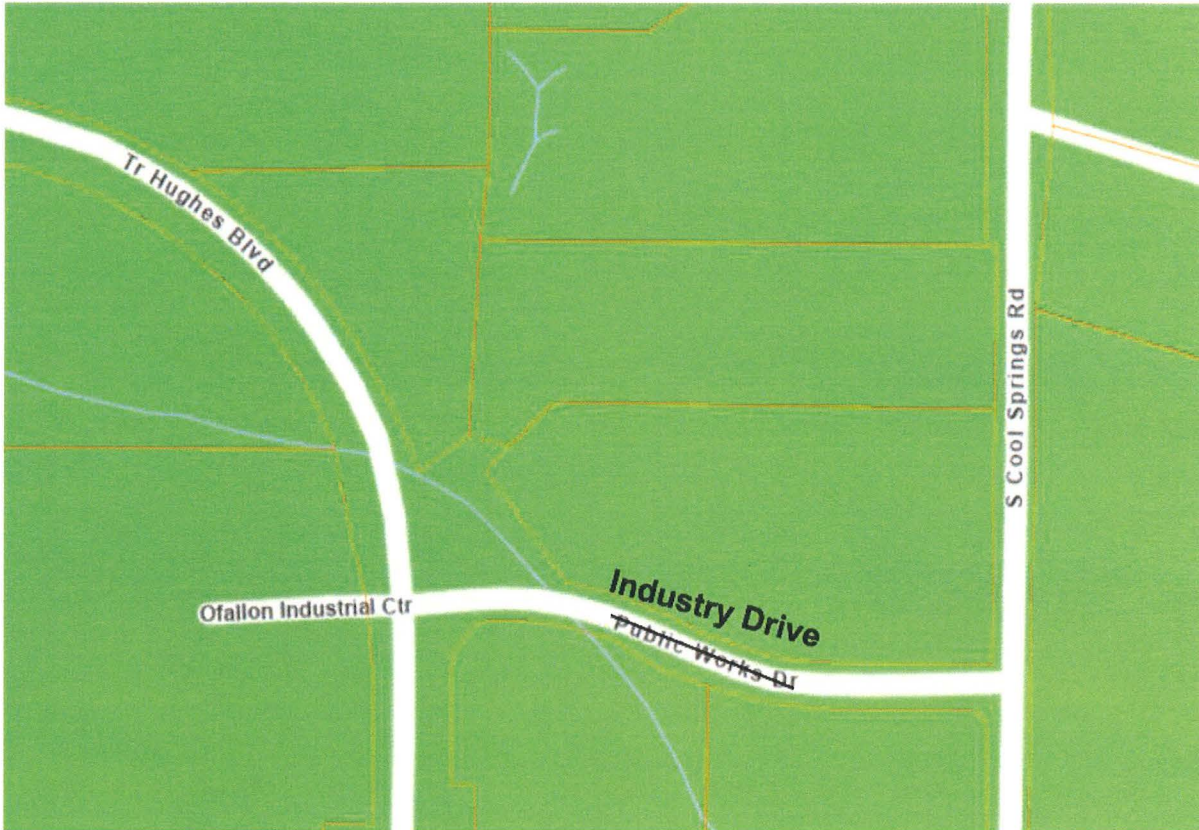
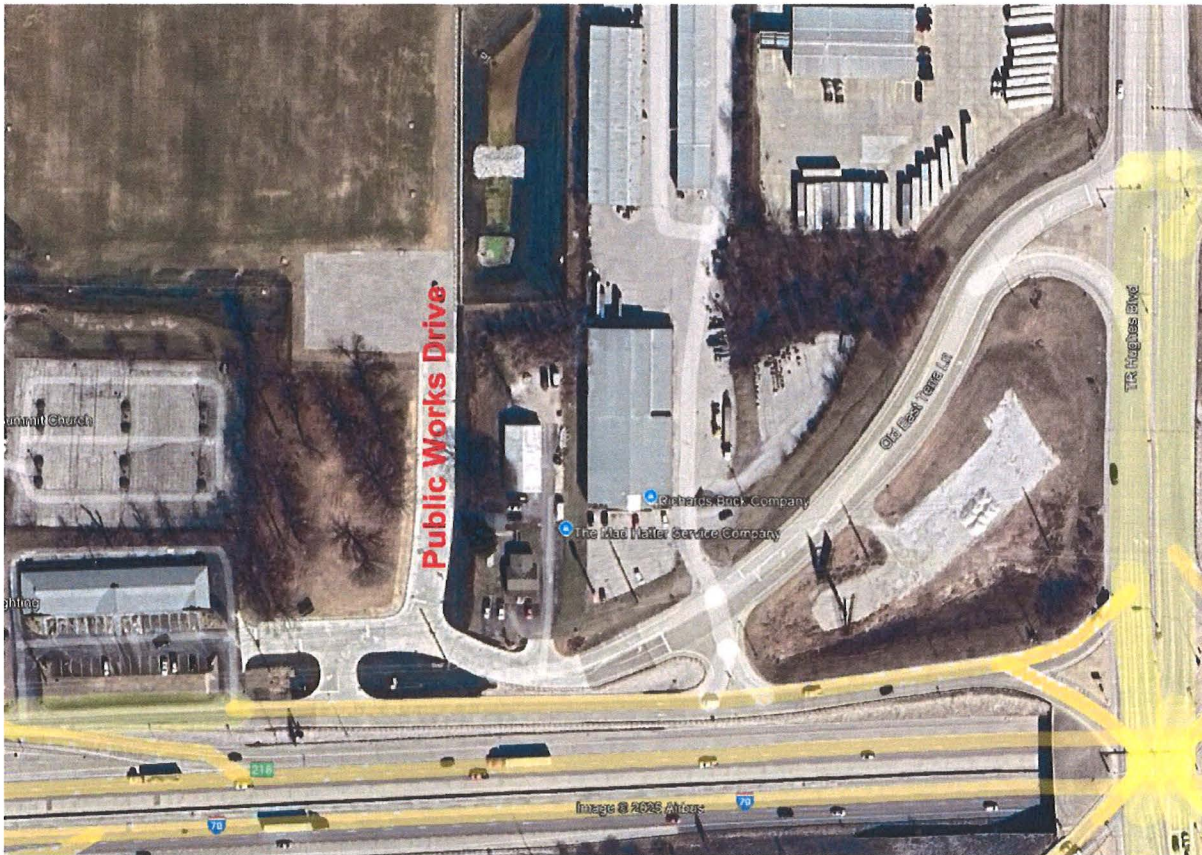
